Laboratory Accreditation



EQAP

- Ensures laboratories are all performing at the same high level of proficiency
- Laboratories have the duty to report results to the Commission within 30 days

Therapeutic Medications

- List of Therapeutic Medications
 - Currently list is 24
 - **▼Thresholds approved by AAEP**
 - Additions are expected
 - ×Study funding will limit

Others – no guidance provided on use;
 jurisdictions treat differently



Therapeutic Medication List



- Criteria for inclusion:
 - FDA Approval for use in the horse (if possible)
 - High level of use among practitioners
 - High number of positives


Third Party Lasix Administration

- Concern regarding additional medications given on race-day
- Successfully administered in several jurisdictions
 - Kentucky
 - Lasix levels normalized
 - Less extraneous noise in testing





Multiple Medication Violation Program



• Concerns:

- Small percentage of trainers are tarnishing image of sport
- Address those who have continual medicationviolations



Multiple Medication Violation Program

- Overlay to existing penalty system
- Points-based system upon severity of medication violation (current ARCI classification)
- Violation occurs if in relevant time period:
 - >1 medication violation
 - ≥ 3 points accrued
- Suspensions range from 30-360 days
- Points (except Class A) can be expunged
