Primary predator was cougar/jaguar category (mountain lion) that runs 62 mph.

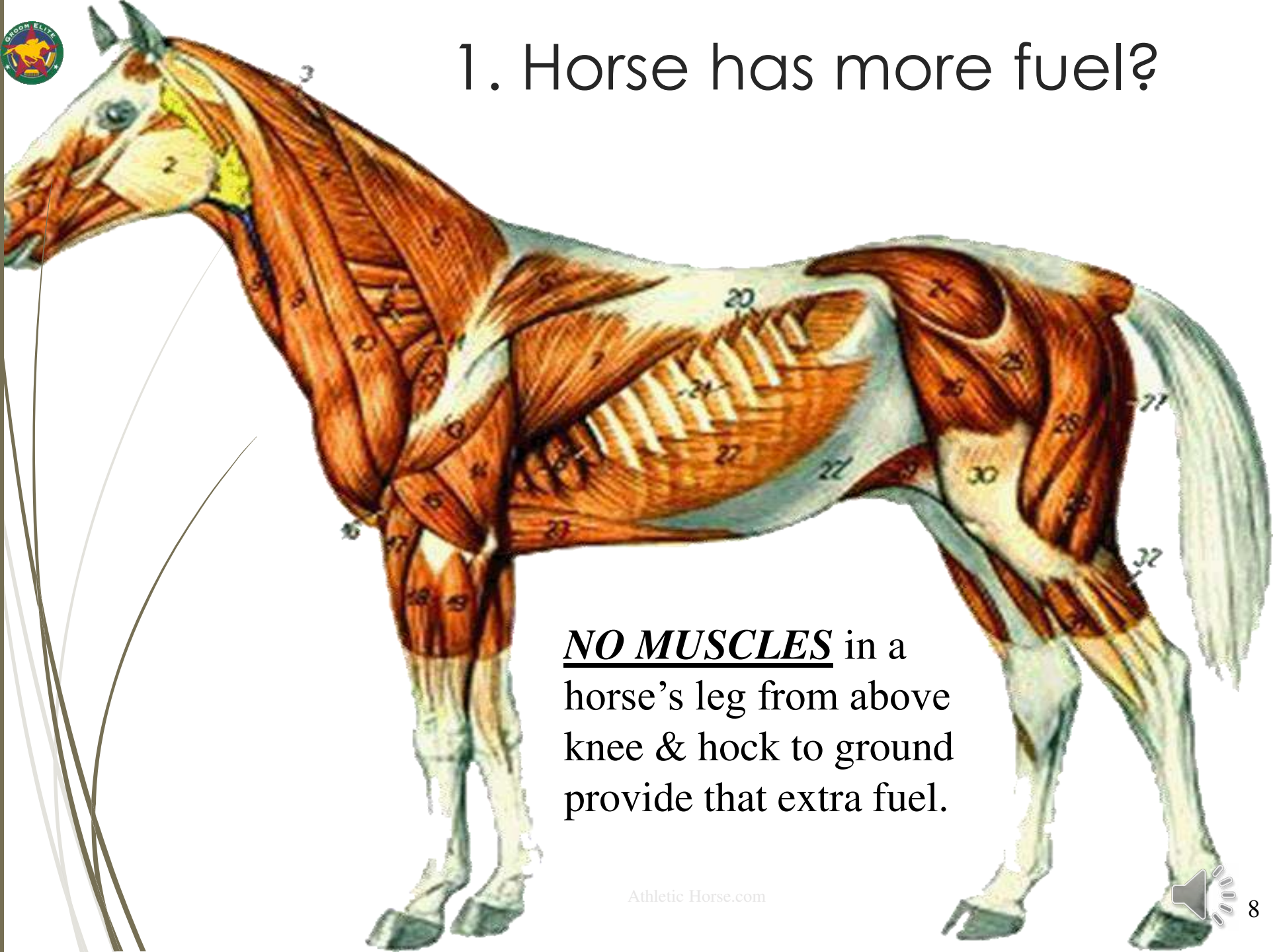
Horses run 35 to 40 mph.
