NEW THIS YEAR

There will be a **Thoroughbred Aftercare Assessment** on all claimed horses at Oaklawn this year. One-half of one percent (.5%) of the claim amount will be added to the claiming price to be paid by the claimant-owner at the time of the claim.

This money will be utilized for thoroughbred aftercare programs mutually approved by the Arkansas HBPA and Oaklawn. There is an option to not be charged this assessment on the claim card and must be checked prior to the claim being dropped.
